Welcome to our year-long study in the Gospel of Luke! We are so excited you've chosen to walk through Luke's Gospel with us. For the next 9 weeks, we will be studying in a way that lends itself to traditional Bible study group/class models. Our "Prepare the Way" study covers Luke 2:39-8:15 and includes some significant moments in the earthly ministry of Christ. We highly encourage you to participate with a group.
