Bible study is not a class you take but a rhythm you keep as a believer.


### HEAR THE WORD

Pray and ask God to supernaturally help you retain what you have read through and learned as you answer the following questions:

- 1. What do you believe was the condition of the scribes' hearts that caused Jesus to refuse answering their question about where His authority came from?
- 2. Looking back at Psalm 80 and Isaiah 5, how do we see the parable of the wicked tenants play out throughout the story of the Bible? What are some "messengers" God uses to get your attention?
- 3. Do you ever struggle with the challenge of what is earthly vs. what is heavenly? How do we operate in this world knowing it is not our home?

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Discuss as a group how to discern when to answer questions or accusations about your faith. As we head into the holidays, what are your thoughts on "answering" the skeptics around your tables?
- 2. Part of what kept the pharisees from trusting Jesus was that it came a threat to their power and position. Have you ever struggled to follow Christ in an area of obedience because it cost you too much? Share.
