## READ THE WORD

- Read **Luke 22:1–46** in the translation you typically read or study. Then, reread **Luke 22:1–46** at least two more times in different translations throughout the week.
- Bonus Reading: **Exodus 12:18–20** and **Isaiah 53**

## STUDY THE WORD

Pray and ask God to supernaturally help you retain what you have read and learned as you answer the following questions:

1. **Why did Jesus arrange a place to eat the Passover with His disciples? What was His main message to them there and to Christians today?**
2. **How does Peter interact with Jesus at the Lord’s Supper? What does Jesus’ response reveal about His character?**
3. **Jesus withdraws to pray privately to His Father. What does Jesus’ example teach us about the importance of prayer?**
4. **What does Jesus teach us about heart posture within prayer?**

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. **Spiritual growth means growing to see our weaknesses, not growing in our greatness. What does this look like in your life?**
2. **Think back on your walk with the Lord. How has your proximity to Jesus affected your life?**
