
Watch the Session Five video. Take notes as you listen and dig into your personal time of study this week.

### READ THE WORD

Read **Luke 22:47–71** in the translation you typically read or study. Then, reread **Luke 22:47–71** at least two more times in different translations throughout the week.

Bonus Reading: Proverbs 16:18 and Hebrews 12:1-4

#### STUDY THE WORD

Pray and ask God to supernaturally help you retain what you have read through and learned as you answer the following questions:

- 1. When Judas betrayed Jesus with a kiss, how does Jesus' respond? What is the meaning of a kiss in this context?
- 2. Compare verse 33 to verse 61. What names of Christ are given? What does this reveal about Jesus?
- 3. Jesus was held in custody, mocked, and beaten; what did His accusers ask Jesus to do? Why was this significant?
- 4. What does Jesus mean when He says, "From now on, the Son of Man shall be seated at the right hand of the power of God?" What does this foretell?
- 5. Jesus didn't say He was the Son of God in verse 70? Instead He turned the answer back on them by saying, "You say that I am?" What does His response tell us?

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. Have you ever been betrayed by someone you loved? How hard would it be to respond like Jesus responded to Judas? Discuss.
- 2. Have you ever seen someone publicly mocked or (heaven forbid) beaten? Describe the feelings you experienced. How do you feel now knowing this happened to our Savior?
