## HEAR THE WORD

## READ THE WORD

Read **Luke 23:1-43** in the translation you typically read or study. Then, reread **Luke 23:1-43** at least two more times in different translations throughout the week.

·Bonus Reading: **Isaiah 53:7-9** and **Philippians 2:7-8**

## STUDY THE WORD

Pray and ask God to supernaturally help you retain what you have read through and learned as you answer the following questions:

1. **(Vs. 4) Pilate found Jesus not guilty of anything wrong; therefore, why was Jesus still persecuted?**
2. **Why was it significant that Pilate and Herod reconciled and what prompted this alliance?**
3. **How many times does it say that Jesus was found not guilty? Why would Jesus still be killed if it was repeatedly said He was not guilty?**

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. **Examine and discuss the prayer uttered by Christ on the cross.**
2. **Discuss: We cannot fully understand God's love until we have understood His wrath against sin and the penalty that comes from it. Why does this make the forgiveness Jesus gave us significant?**
