## READ THE WORD

•Read Luke 23:1–43 in the translation you typically read or study. Then, reread Luke 23:1–43 at least two more times in different translations throughout the week. •Bonus Reading: Isaiah 53:7–9 and Philippians 2:7–8

## STUDY THE WORD

Pray and ask God to supernaturally help you retain what you have read through and learned as you answer the following questions:

- 1. (Vs. 4) Pilate found Jesus not guilty of anything wrong; therefore, why was Jesus still persecuted?
- 2. Why was it significant that Pilate and Herod reconciled and what prompted this alliance?
- 3. How many times does it say that Jesus was found not guilty? Why would Jesus still be killed if it was repeatedly said He was not guilty?

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. Examine and discuss the prayer uttered by Christ on the cross.
- 2. Discuss: We cannot fully understand God's love until we have understood His wrath against sin and the penalty that comes from it. Why does this make the forgiveness Jesus gave us significant?
