HEAR THE WORD

·Bonus Reading: **Psalm 31 and Leviticus 16:6–10**

STUDY THE WORD

Pray and ask God to supernaturally help you retain what you have read through and learned as you answer the following questions:

1. **Jesus, in His final breath, said “Father, into your hands I commit my spirit.” What about this phrase is significant to you?**
2. **What is a scapegoat in Scripture, and how does it relate to Jesus? For whom did He take the place?**
3. **In His death, burial and resurrection, Jesus showed ultimate power over death. Why is this good news for us?**

1. **Have you ever had a moment where you “surrendered all” to God. Share your testimony of salvation.**
