

STUDY THE WORD

Pray and ask God to supernaturally help you retain what you have read through and learned as you answer the following questions:

- 1. Jesus chose to reveal Himself over the breaking of bread, just as He did at the Last Supper. Is this significant? Why?
- 2. What is the difference between a witness and an observer?
- 3. The Cross and the rest of Christ's ministry were prophesied long before they happened. Why is this important?
- 4. Can we understand Scripture entirely on our own? What helps us know God's Word and apply it to our life?
- 5. Read Matthew 28:18-20. In these two passages, we are called witnesses; based on these verses, what is our role as witnesses?

- 1. How is our perception of the world and our understanding of truth shaped by the Gospel?
- 2. What has encouraged you most over the course of what you've studied in the Gospel of Luke?
